## If God agreed with you...

So there we are, pointing towards those who bring us trouble. Our leaders surely are failing us. Please get rid of them, Dear Lord. Ever felt like saying that? What if you did, and God agreed with you. The next morning, reports come out that certain leaders passed away during the night.

Now, God looks down from heaven searching for the person whom he will raise up to fill the newly vacant seats.

Will you be found prepared, right for the job? Or will you simply be next in line, victim of the next round of prayers from the people that seek **your** removal?

Two verses come to mind.

• Luke 16:10 "He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful also in much; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much.

Have you prepared yourself to be successful in big things by being faithful in small things. If not, then consider not going forward until you have addressed your own issues.

• Psalm 106:15 So He gave them their request, but sent a wasting disease among them.

Think twice before forwarding your own ideas. Humans choose poorly, and every idea has a negative side, a wasting disease, that we may not have foreseen. Back at verse 13, this Psalm accuses us of having forgotten how good God's choices are. Consider God's track record versus your own.

We've had such conversations in Haiti over many years. It was not so much a speech but a discussion and a challenge. And then I'd get the privilege of coming back to the states to tell you that after completing 2.5 hours without a break they asked for another 2.5 hours. Or how a 4 hour class took just one 20 minute break each day at the student's request.


Yes, the discussions may be "droning on" for American audiences, but Haiti was almost insatiable. We are missing those days in Haiti.
