If we had to give our Seedtime update in one verse, this would probably say it best...

## Galations 6:9

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

Yes, Frantz made a short report last week and nothing was looking good at the moment.

Our <u>March 22-24th</u> Bible study was **canceled** due to lack of student enrollment. Why they went from interested to disinterested is unknown.

The March 29-31 Bible study was also **canceled**. The Pastor increased the price of the class from 40 Haitian dollars (2.52 usd) to 150 Haitian dollars (9.46 usd). We require the 40 Haitian dollars in order to draw the serious students only. Those who are serious and still too poor are often subsidized. It works well. In this case the Pastor asked for additional money up front to provide the class with meals. It quickly becomes too much financially and no one signs up.

The <u>April 1-3rd</u> classes were **canceled** due to lack of student enrollment. The Pastor simply added our classes to the already full Easter schedule. Members were likely exhausted and focused rightly on Holy week programming.

Discouragement is easy as we see Haiti melting so far into chaos. Even a foreign national soccer team visiting Haiti *with* a police escort got held up by gangs last week. Google searches continue to show street protests with thousands upon thousands in the streets. Now we see churches struggling to know their congregations well enough not to exhaust them physically or financially.

Shame on us as well as both Brian and Frantz have experienced these troubles in the past. We know of these kinds of problems and we failed to address them.


Reminiscent of John 6:68, we have no where else to go. Giving up is not really an option. Frantz and Brian are looking for opportunities to control our own venues for class or be more diligent about rules for those hosting our seminars.
