There is no big news to share regarding Haiti's high profile challenges.

- * Presidential election planning,
- * controlling gangs and
- * earthquake recovery

In Frantz' latest brief report he said

- * he has been sick recently. The doctor told him it was not covid.
- * gangs are attempting to control the distribution of gasoline out of Port-au-Prince (PauP),
 - * a friend of Frantz was kidnapped while in PauP and
- * 3 people were recently killed in Port-de-Paix (where Frantz lives).
- * Seedtime Bible classes around Port-de-Paix are still being scheduled but he hopes to get 2 groups in September.

It is seldom an easy week for Haiti. Frantz never gave the name of the kid-napped friend, nor the stories behind the 3 separate shootings in his city.

Sadly, we may be seeing a little jadedness in our own responses.
Nevertheless, we know prayer is needed.
