At which time, amongst other recreations, we exercised our arms, many of the Indians coming amongst us, and among the rest their greatest king, Massasoit, with some ninety men, whom for three days we entertained and feasted; and they went out and killed five deer, which they brought to the plantation and bestowed on our governor, and upon the captain and others. And although it be not always so plentiful as it was at this time with us, yet by the goodness of God, we are so far from want.

The **17 Haiti missionaries kidnapped** weeks ago are still being held by kidnapers. Also, gangs still control many areas of the Capital city and throughout the country. Still could use prayer!

**Another Bible study is postponed.** The Bible study, scheduled for Nov 18, 19 and 20th in Port-de-Paix was postponed as the Pastor left town just before the first class without communicating with Frantz. Getting started is often a challenge, but once they begin things turn very positive. We remain hopeful for a second chance to begin with this group.

**Supplies are now received by Frantz** after a few months of trial and error. The last of the glitches included Haitian police delaying unloading as they searched for guns rumored to be among the cargo onboard.

**Brian began two Bible studies in Derby, Kansas** last week. These are the same studies we do in Haiti. I lured just 2 attendees to each of the classes. Both couples were very good students with wonderful discussions the entire time. It was a good beginning but Brian hopes for more.

**Now for the fun stuff.**

- ◆ Frantz completed about 15 hours of Bible study over 3 days in a church in Mare Rouge, Haiti Nov 1, 2, 3, 2021
- ◆ 16 students worked 3 days to complete our study.
- ◆ They represented 7 churches and included 4 Pastors and 1 Assoc. Pastor.
- ◆ 9 of them teach classes in their respective churches.
- ◆ 6 have jobs teaching in public schools.
- ◆ 4 said they had read the whole bible and that included 2 Pastors and one Associate Pastor.
- ◆ Frantz distributed 58 Bible reading calendars to the 16 students challenging them to find reading partners amongst their spouses or friends and get reading... every day!

**A couple specific students were mentioned by Frantz.**

**BORNELUS Modeline.** She is an elementary school teacher. She said she will gather a group of people and teach them what she learned in our class.

**SAINLUCNOR Guillet** was the oldest person in class. He asked a lot of questions and he was awesome. He seemed to like all the chapters. He mentioned liking chapters 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 9, and 10. He said the seminar increased his spiritual knowledge and he will teach this course to others.
