Remember that Frantz is offering these groups a 15 hour Bible study for about \$2 US dollars each.

It comes with a book of Bible verses in their language.

He offers no food, no drink, no diploma.

No sponsorship or gifts.

In a country where many missionaries give things for free plus add on gifts and sponsorship, this is not an easy sell. Indeed few are ready to sign on to our study. Frantz now gets the privilege of wrestling with that challenge.

But those who sign on have yet to request their class fee returned though we offer it each time. We are well into our second decade of happy students.

In his last class, Frantz not only received the student's fee, but they sent him home with a sack full of mangoes, Haitian lemons, a banana and peanuts. Not bad for a group that initially thought to not attend.
