#### Discipleship seminars scheduled for July

at LaPointe July 5-7th postponed after Pastor had a stroke.

at Aubert July 11-13th postponed until church roof is completed.\*

at Jean Rabel July 18-20th tentative, can't locate the Pastor to confirm.

at Latendri July 25-27 postponed til 28-30th

\* This is the church that is rebuilding from scratch after the Haitian government made a road through their existing location. The church leadership made the decision to postpone, not Frantz. This is unusual since most churches we visit have only partial roofs or walls.

Frantz does a good job visiting the locations in the weeks ahead of their scheduled time. He speaks at the churches during regular services and calls the Pastor or responsible person. Nevertheless, the results are out of his control.

On the brighter side, our shipping has gone as planned. We began July 1st with 3 boxes on Old Dominion Freight lines in Wichita, Ks. They arrived in Miami in time to be loaded onboard the Haitian cargo ship and that boat should arrive at Port-de-Paix July 15th or 16th. Frantz will probably have the supplies personally in hand about July 20th.

#### What did we ship you ask?

112 Bible study books, 560 Bible reading calendars, flashlights, batteries, 12 volt fan, mosquito spray, sawyer water filter, diarrhea pills, triple antibiotic ointment, band-aids, ponchos, notepads and a Bible.

Why yes, it *is* a glamorous life in the mission field!

Maybe all this 'little bit of nothing' update lets you know the disappointing and mundane parts so you can pray better.

Not that you are praying poorly, but just in case you were in the dark about routine troubles Frantz experiences.

...or perhaps this *is* the good life compared to what it could be. In that case, thank you all for your prayers and please don't take this as a complaint!
