TIME TO GET ON THE ROAD AS RADIO BROADCASTS TAKE A BACK SEAT

Back to class for Frantz. He has been on Haitian radio station many times in June and now he is on the road for most of July.

June 28, 29 and 30th Frantz was scheduled to teach a discipleship class south of Port-de-Paix at Demaro United Pentecostal church. This church is closer to gang controlled territory than usual and that caused problems. Haitian police shot a gang member in a nearby zone causing remaining gang members to scatter. As some entered the area around the church the gang shot a farmer who was trying to let others know the gang was arriving. Frantz could not get through road blocks on the first day of class but did



reach the church on the second day. It was empty as members were afraid to go outside their homes. No surprise that Frantz said the Demaro Pastor decided to postpone.

We appreciate your prayers for Haiti, the

church and for Frantz. We are glad for his bravery and effort but very much want him to remain safe as well.

Summer vacation is prime time for activities of all types in and out of the Haitian church. The July schedule has Frantz looking at 4 separate locations for seminars. July 5th, 6th and 7th has Frantz at a church in La Point, Haiti, not too far from his home. The 11th, 12th and 13th is at a church in Aubert. We highlighted the Aubert church briefly a couple months ago as they were rebuilding after the government turned their location into a public road. Frantz will be presenting his discipleship course to them on this visit.

July 18th, 19th and 20th puts Frantz a bit farther from home in <u>Jean Rabel</u> but still a place that should be just fine safety-wise. Lastly, **July 25th, 26th** and 27th should be at <u>Emmanuel Baptist in Latendrie</u> which we think is a neighborhood within the city of Port-de-Paix.


