Since our last Newsletter in June

- ♦ **Frantz recovery** In case you missed it before, Frantz has recovered nicely from a motorcycle accident he had while being driven back home from a Discipleship Bible study earlier this year. Yay!
- Discipleship classes going well We have had the usual struggles to get classes to begin but when they did, classes went very well. Recently Frantz completed a group of 4 quality students in late July and a group of 20 (correction from 19 reported earlier). Frantz said the students told him the first day to bring more books the second day because more were coming. And they did.
- Supplies arrived We saw our shipment finally arrive in Haiti with more Books and needed supplies to restock Frantz. The delivery was delayed as the Haitian government found guns and ammunition also onboard the cargo ship (of course nothing of ours). Someone told us that illegal guns were a bigger problem than drug trafficking these days. Because of this, cargo ships may now be required to deliver only to the capital, Port-au-Prince. The capital is about 7 hours by bus from Frantz and goes through gang controlled areas, making retrieval of future shipments dangerous or painfully expensive. Prayer requested.
