Frantz reported that **Haitian police shot 5 gang members** in Port-de-Paix where he lives. Schools scheduled to open Oct 3rd have not yet opened. Gasoline prices are down to \$30 usd per gallon (yes, this is lower than last week!)

The first discipleship Bible seminar scheduled for October has been postponed by their pastor. However, Frantz did get 12 minutes on the radio with Bethany FM this week. Praise the Lord for something that wasn't closed!

Frantz notified us that the **US embassy in Haiti was calling for all Americans to leave**. In his usual positive tone, Frantz decided to use the time to thank the Lord for opening doors into Haiti for years, allowing us to come and teach him the message he is now teaching.

We received a message from **American missionary friends** who are full time in Haiti and have been for most of their lives. They had returned to Haiti just a few weeks ago but **returned stateside** saying the gangs and protests gave them little opportunity to do anything at the moment.

We have received some donations for Frantz to have a Christmas bonus. But there is **still time if you wish to add your gift for Frantz**. We will send it to him in early December. Thank you very much for thinking of Frantz!
