Schools in Port-de-Paix, Haiti are back open. It's a good sign coming a few weeks after gangs left the city. Gas prices per gallon are down from a high of \$1000 Haitian dollars to \$280 (\$10 US).

The photo of Frantz with his wife and daughter is not from desperate times when gangs controlled the city. No, this is just a normal day. No indoor plumbing here. No safe-to-drink water pressurized to flow easily on demand.

And normally you are alone with a pitcher of water to pour over yourself. Here Frantz is demonstrating a perfect day when someone aids you in washing up for dinner.

We say all this to tell you that you have been generous to Frantz with a Christmas bonus this year of \$1100 US. He will receive it this month.

- Frantz has done well this year. Despite a "normal" challenging life in Haiti, Frantz had covid sickness and a motorcycle crash without the benefit of decent medical options.
- He traveled many miles to meet dozens of Pastors and church leaders where 2 out of 3 would schedule and change the schedule and then cancel. He perseveres, thanking God for each church that attends the 15 hour discipleship seminar.
- He stepped up to the plate when invited periodically to teach on 5 or 6 different Haitian radio stations. Those opportunities continue.
 - It's fun to hear Frantz describe the variety of interactions he has with fellow Haitians along the way, taking time to give little teachings everywhere he goes while he waits for normal life to unfold.

He has 2 more seminars scheduled in December so his teaching materials will need replenished soon. Mulvane Christian Church in Mulvane, Kansas printed our textbooks for us. (yay!!) Others have given support to allow us to pay for the remaining supplies and ministry costs. Now we need prayer for the shipment phase. The boat that takes our supplies has never lost a thing of ours, yet it is *very* unpredictable, making connections challenging. The boat was held by the Haitian government and is now released to make repairs before shipping again, maybe at the end of the month.

Someone out there knows how to pray for this, right?
