We been on both sides of this kind of story. We've underrated some good things, missing out on opportunities. And we've been like Frantz, offering something good only to have it overlooked by the public and we seem to be wasting time.

 But Frantz perseveres and tracks folks down like this Monfort church Pastor to get God's Word in front of them. I recall a college professor boldly saying to me once, "Let me intrude upon your day..." I was missing a great opportunity and he was willing to push me.

The Monfort Pastor, who did not attend, told Frantz he would cover the cost of 5 church members to attend our seminar. None of them showed up. We believe finances are not what motivates folks. It's hearing God's call that drives people. Pastors are in a prime position to amplify the call. In this case the Pastor's generous cash offer did not overcome his lack of presence.

On-air radio teaching time continues for Frantz. Every week he is invited 1 to 3 times. Occasionally he is with other Pastors for a panel discussion.

- It seems like a little bit of nothing now... but we see it as God's preparation for bigger things.
- Frantz spoke with a Haitian man who is setting up yet another radio station in Haiti. The owner is saying he will offer Frantz a 1 hour time slot Monday through Friday once he gets his station set up. Today, those are just words... again, just a little bit of nothin. But we see God building something bigger that we had hoped. It's always worth praying for today's "little bit of nothin".
