Seedtime's 3 day Bible study seminar continues to lose traction in the area around Port-de-Paix, Haiti.

From Haiti, Frantz Pierre-Louis said this past week that one Pastor passed away suddenly, canceling the Bible study scheduled with his church. Another Pastor simply postponed their Bible study with Frantz for unknown reasons. It's something different each time. The door to in-person Bible studies is not so fully open these days.

Frantz is still working hard to meet students face-to-face, especially as Easter break provides opportunities that may not come again until summer break. He is also planning a "Passion of the Christ" type movie event to evangelize folks, but still has not settled on a venue.

On the other hand, radio broadcast invitations keep coming.



Thursday he was on-air at Formidable Radio for an 8am broadcast. And today (Friday) he has a 3:30 pm session at Bethany Radio and then at 8:40 PM at Menace Radio. These are all Bible teaching and preaching moments on Haitian radio stations.

The radio ministry is a big blessing for Seedtime's discipleship outreach, a big halleluiah moment. It is efficient with time and money, presumably reaching a lot of people. **But**, whether we like it or not, God is shifting, so that his rain increasing comes through Seedtime via radio.

It is obvious that God is opening that door, giving Frantz valuable experience each week. What we do not see is a call to end our in-person Bible studies. Yes, classroom opportunities are hard to come by. But, personally, we prefer the in-class experience. Student questions can be answered more readily and we get feedback sooner.

The presentation of God's Word is shifting towards radio and less through the classroom. We plan to stand in both places and allow God to decide how much rain and from what direction. The radio stations keep calling Frantz. And more teaching supplies for classes are on their way to Frantz even now.

Perhaps we can convince you to pray for rain from both directions. God's Word... not coming back empty. Bearing fruit in salvation and righteousness.
