Good News Well Received By 18 in Haiti



DISCIPLESHIP FOR THOSE ALREADY BELIEVING

<u>Who attended</u>? Our previous newsletter mentioned a Haitian church (photo left) that had a zero attendance for a scheduled Bible study. Not just a single class but a 3 day pre-planned, pre-approved seminar. Not even attended by those whose class fee was paid for them. May we note that the church we speak of had a clean finished build.



We mention it because we see a pattern of low or no attendance in nice churches. Our recent class at Church of God of Ephesus April 5,6 and 8th was well attended, beginning with 17 and finishing with 18. As you can see in the photo (right), the building is a hodgepodge of tin and wood cobbled together.

Perhaps it isn't statistically relevant, but we think there just might be a connection between "poverty" and "the next level down" in poverty, when assessing spiritual hunger. According to Frantz, the class at Ephesus even had 5 more who hung out around the edges listening in on the class. We never see that in the upper class churches.



We bring this up to our prosperous American friends <u>as a warning</u> to look around and consider how open you and your church are to paying, in time and money, for a 3 day Bible study just as these Church of God members did. Or by any measure you want to use, how's your spiritual hunger, growing each day or a zero?

<u>Another pattern</u> we see continuing in the Haitian church... When asked if they had read the whole Bible, only 1 student in this latest class said yes. And that one wasn't the one Associate Pastor in attendance. On top of that, 6 said they were teachers in the church.

The caution light is flashing... 1) Are we taking our Christian membership a bit too lightly?

2) "prosperity" isn't the friend we think it is.

We appreciate Frantz working hard to get every church invited to a Bible study. And we love being a part of motivating them to read the Bible for themselves long after we are gone.

Thank you for your part in prayers and finance so the resources are there for Seedtime to continue.
