### A Friend Who Walks With You

Frantz keeps finding Pastors throughout Port-de-Paix, Haiti, introducing them to Seedtime's Bible study. Just this past week he met a Pastor who asked him if God **did or did not** like co-signing. Frantz replied, **are you asking me or asking God?**

Together they read Proverbs 22:26-27, Proverbs 17:18, Proverbs 11:15 and finally Proverbs 6:1-5. The Pastor sheepishly said he often helps his congregation by co-signing loans for them.

Frantz gently asked the Pastor **if he would be strong enough** to tell his members what God said about this activity. If not, Frantz said he would come along with him to strengthen him, or if needed he would share this information with them on the Pastor's behalf.

Proverbs 6:5

Free yourself, like a gazelle from the hand of the hunter, like a bird from the snare of the fowler.

(Remember, Frantz is speaking to a believer. Freedom in this verse is not "salvation", since salvation is never earned by adhering to rules. But now in discipleship, we'd ask, do you know what pleases God and do you care to adjust your life as you come to know more?)

Frantz is waiting for the Pastor to decide how he will handle his situation. This is the kind of decision making you will never hear about on the nightly news, but surely God loves those who continue to draw near little by little.
