I didn't ask but I bet Elisiane was not isolated in a back bedroom sleeping, but most likely in the middle of the room being prayed over. (I did ask, and yes, she was in the center room with hands laid on her.)

Frantz called this a beautiful moment. Americans would likely have screamed either outwardly or inside their spirits... two hours with so many people and so little privacy or rest? Yep, welcome to a beautiful moment. We greatly appreciate their heart for God.

Frantz has since taken her to a doctor and had blood tests done. Results are still pending. For now Elisiane is feeling better.
