Our Bible study seminar ended June 20th. 10 students finished the last of 3 days of discipleship Bible study!

<u>Promised Land Church of God</u> hosted our study last week and we were delighted just to see it completed. Frantz even had one blind man attend who bought two of our study books for his children.

Student books cost \$1.54 at today's exchange rate and then the class is free otherwise. As usual the book is fully refundable if the student is unhappy for any reason. Also as usual, no one was interested in a refund... they just appreciated the teaching and are asking for more.

We do our poor friends in Haiti a disservice when we sponsor every last piece of their lives. The fee we request is so manageable that it really serves only to detect if a person has any room in their heart to hear God's Word. In 15 years of this, we've not had a single person ask for a refund. Of course we work with those who truly want to join in but can not afford the class.

When Frantz sends us the full class report, we'll share details of who was there and what their responses were. For now, we are content that 10 more people were getting discipled.
