### 7 words to introduce our Bible Reading Calendars

**Our calendars** organize the reader to get through the entire New Testament in less than 1 year. It's simplified and it's free but Frantz works to select those who show interest in reading. His radio Bible teaching is a great platform for reaching people.

Frantz had just received the new calendars and by the time we spoke he had already given out 10 to radio listeners and people who called into his program that day.

Our best estimate is 16 radio stations that have had Frantz come to teach the Bible. Some are regulars and some are sporadic. Either way, we say Thank you Jesus for this open door. And thank you to those who finance us, allowing us to enter those doors with our Bible materials.
