What did you just think about?

Regarding our title, "Haiti Missions Needs Support", did you just think about us asking for money? That's the go-to answer for most of the world. They throw money at nearly everything, expecting that to be the answer. But, is it true?

Consider one very short Bible moment with Apostle Paul from Acts 16:9-10

In Acts 16 Paul had a vision of a Macedonian man calling out for "help". Paul immediately knew he needed to go to that man, not with money, but to present the gospel. As Paul understood his calling, he first thought to provide that which God had prepared in him. If you understand *your* calling, then it would be normal for you to do the same... that is to consider your calling as the help being requested.

 - He conducts in-person Bible seminars and short format teachings.
