Habakkuk 3:17-19

Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls,  
<sup>18</sup> **yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior.**  
<sup>19</sup> **The Sovereign LORD is my strength;** he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, **he enables me** to tread on the heights.

1. Haiti's own Presidential Council has failed to provide security sufficient to hold Presidential elections. Nevertheless, they supposedly plan to begin registration for voters in November, yes, this month, a first election in December and a final election in January.
2. The United Nations sent a UN force well over 1 year ago, to provide the promised security but was underfunded, understaffed and unsuccessful.
3. Often, troubles are met with violent activism. Haiti likes to burn, break, and steal things. Read as Habakkuk does none of this, instead finding a strength in the Hope of God to once again deal with calamity.

People can respond to trouble differently, and better, when they know God and hear his word. And mercifully, Frantz is back behind the microphone following the flooding rains of Hurricane Melissa. Once again, Frantz steps up to the microphone and speaks about God's authority, his presence, his love and our need to call on God.


Aren't we all glad that Frantz is there to speak these words?
