1. Frantz got banged up in a moped accident last week, hitting his face and leg. The leg may take awhile to heal, but we don't know enough yet. For now it's bed rest for our hardworking brother-in-Christ.

2. Prior to that, Frantz was disappointed as *another* church leader canceled their Bible study scheduled with Frantz during the Kanaval festival in February. It's difficult to know who is serious in their search for knowing God. The routine disappointments can wear on a person, especially when we see it coming from church leadership.

3. A new attempt by Haiti to defeat gangs is set to begin in April when UN sponsored gsf (gang suppression forces) begin to arrive. The "Transitional Presidential Council" is now disbanded. The country is headed by a Prime Minister appointed in late 2024. Current plans are to hold the 1st round of Haiti's elections August 30th, a full year beyond their previous failed plan.


4. Yet another radio station is preparing to open in Port-de-Paix, Haiti. Modern Vision FM Radio invited Frantz to come talk with them off-air seeking his advice. We have not heard if this happened or not, but we enjoy knowing Frantz is being sought out by the owners. God keeps opening doors!!

5. In between rains that flooded city streets in the last couple weeks, Frantz was on-air doing Bible teaching with RTG, GH, Formidable and Tele-bouje FM stations. Frantz also uses these opportunities to distribute Bible reading calendars to listeners. This is no small outreach and we praise God for it!

6. Lastly, we are looking for a shipment of ministry supplies sent March 2025. Yes, one year ago! We are hoping to see it arrive this month. We have since shipped 2 other boxes bringing our shipment total to three 50 pound boxes. This is how we resupply Frantz with curriculum and bible calendars, so we ask you to pray for this as well.
