In case you were wondering...

For quite some time, we've been encouraging Frantz to reduce his ministry time and focus more on himself and his family. Frantz has strong gifting for discipleship and it seems many churches and radio stations know it. They are calling often and Frantz loves to say yes. So, discipleship is going well at that level. Few people are so comfortable putting on a headset and talking over the radio to teach the Bible to a large city. Nevertheless, we also make it clear that Frantz must not neglect his family.

We've shipped him many books for his daughters. We've encouraged him to take time to stay home and read to them. We've encouraged him to take his wife to dinner or simply buy quality food that he can make at home with his wife. (Spaghetti and hot dogs are all too common and difficult for Haitians to see beyond.) We've encouraged him to take more time for praying and reading God's word outside of the public eye. Even these small things are difficult to make happen due to health issues, costs, or simply being excessively busy with 3rd world manual life.

Pray for Frantz to balance his call inside his home with the many calls he gets from the community.

I doubt this is unfamiliar with any of our Seedtime Friends. Balancing responsibilities is a challenge. Just ask Samuel how it went with his sons or Eli the priest, or with King David. Being fully present with the family is something worth praying for and acting upon.

We have a budget category for Frantz to use for his own personal growth. He has full control of that account... but he conserves that too, likely thinking it will be gone too easily. If you want to go beyond prayer, maybe that is one way to contribute.

Thank you for walking with us is not just a tag line. There are many parts to ministering the Word of God and we can all use prayer, counsel, and encouragement.
