Seedtime's discipleship in Haiti is temporarily on hold. As you read this, Frantz, his wife and his youngest daughter Jade are trying something not tried in years.... Traveling the long road to Haiti's capital Port-au-Prince. Gangs own many of the highways and extort money or kidnap or both. At last report the travel is taking over 12 hours for what is normally 7 or 8 hours. Frantz says the government's Gang Suppression Force (GSF) has not been seen in months.

Nevertheless, Jade's kidney function is deteriorating and the local doctor referred her to the specialist in Port-au-Prince. After prayerful consideration Frantz decided to leave his daughter Gaelle in Port-de-Paix and take Elisiane and Jade on the bus and risk the travel.

The bus left Thursday and the appointment with the doctor is Friday August 21st. The travel is scarier than the doctor's visit. Please be in prayer for mercy in both the health issues and the travel concerns.

Believe it or not Frantz has managed to have time on a few radio stations in the last couple weeks after he could walk again following his fall and before the brunt of the family illnesses hit. But none of us are focused on teaching discipleship at the moment. Instead Frantz is living those disciplines.

And we are happy to see Frantz persevering. He knows God is with him and keeps moving forward. None of their family illness and injuries are completely resolved. Still Frantz and Elisiane trust their prayers are being answered and in time they will come out of it with praise for God.

We expect a depth of spiritual insight is being built into Frantz since he is given so much access to the hearts and minds of so many listeners in Haiti.
