It's hard work and she hopefully found shade. Water is hauled in buckets. Rinsing clothes is the same process, hand rinsing and wringing each piece. Then someone hangs the clothes on anything available for drying. Dedicated clothes lines are not normal. Every step is laborious.

This friend made it a labor of love.

Rich or poor we can see when a person loves. It inspires us to be a friend.

In America we see great amounts of time saving technology, but there is no substitute for acts of love.

In our world people get a T-shirt with some catchy message to inspire the world, like... I want to wash for You. Better still is simply being the one who greets tired people at their door, ready to serve.

May God bless this friend who loved well. And may we do likewise.

In other news:

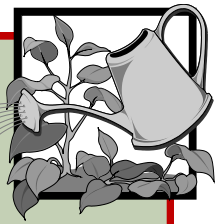
Frantz is back in Port-de-Paix, his home town, rested and getting back to discipleship on the radio across the city.
